**FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS REGARDING
THE NOVEMBER 3, 2020 ELECTION**

The Clerk's Office is fielding many calls about the upcoming November Election. In an effort to disseminate the correct information, please feel free to share this information.

- **When can I vote absentee in person (in the Clerk's Office)?**
 - October 20 – October 30, 2020 by APPOINTMENT ONLY. Please call ahead. (On October 30, the Clerk's Office will be open until 5 pm.)

- **Will a voting machine be set up in your office during in person absentee voting for me to put my ballot in?**
 - No, a machine will not be set up for you to put your ballot in. You will place your ballot in a certified envelope that you sign and your ballot will be processed on Election Day by the Election Workers.

- **Can I hand deliver my absentee ballot back to the Clerk's Office rather than mail it back?**
 - Yes, you can hand deliver your absentee ballot to the Clerk's Office by APPOINTMENT ONLY during in person absentee voting starting OCTOBER 20TH- 30TH the hours of 9am – 3pm.

- **Can the Clerk's Office witness my absentee ballot envelope for me?**
 - No, the Clerk's Office CANNOT witness your absentee ballot for you if mailed back. You will need a witness signature and address on the envelope prior to mailing it back. If you come in to drop off your ballot the Clerk's office CAN witness for you.

- **I am receiving lots of mailings from different groups about requesting an absentee ballot. I already filled out a request for my absentee ballot. Do I have to fill this mailing out again?**
 - If you have already requested an absentee ballot for the November election, you should not fill out another request.

- **Why am I getting all this mail about requesting an absentee ballot?**
 - Different groups and parties are mailing this information to you. The Town of Baileys Harbor HAS NOT and DOES NOT intend to mail you any information about you requesting an absentee ballot. However, we cannot stop these types of mailings from appearing in your mailbox.

- **Do I have to pay postage to mail my absentee ballot back to the City Clerk's Office?**
 - No, you do not. Your return envelope will already have postage on.
